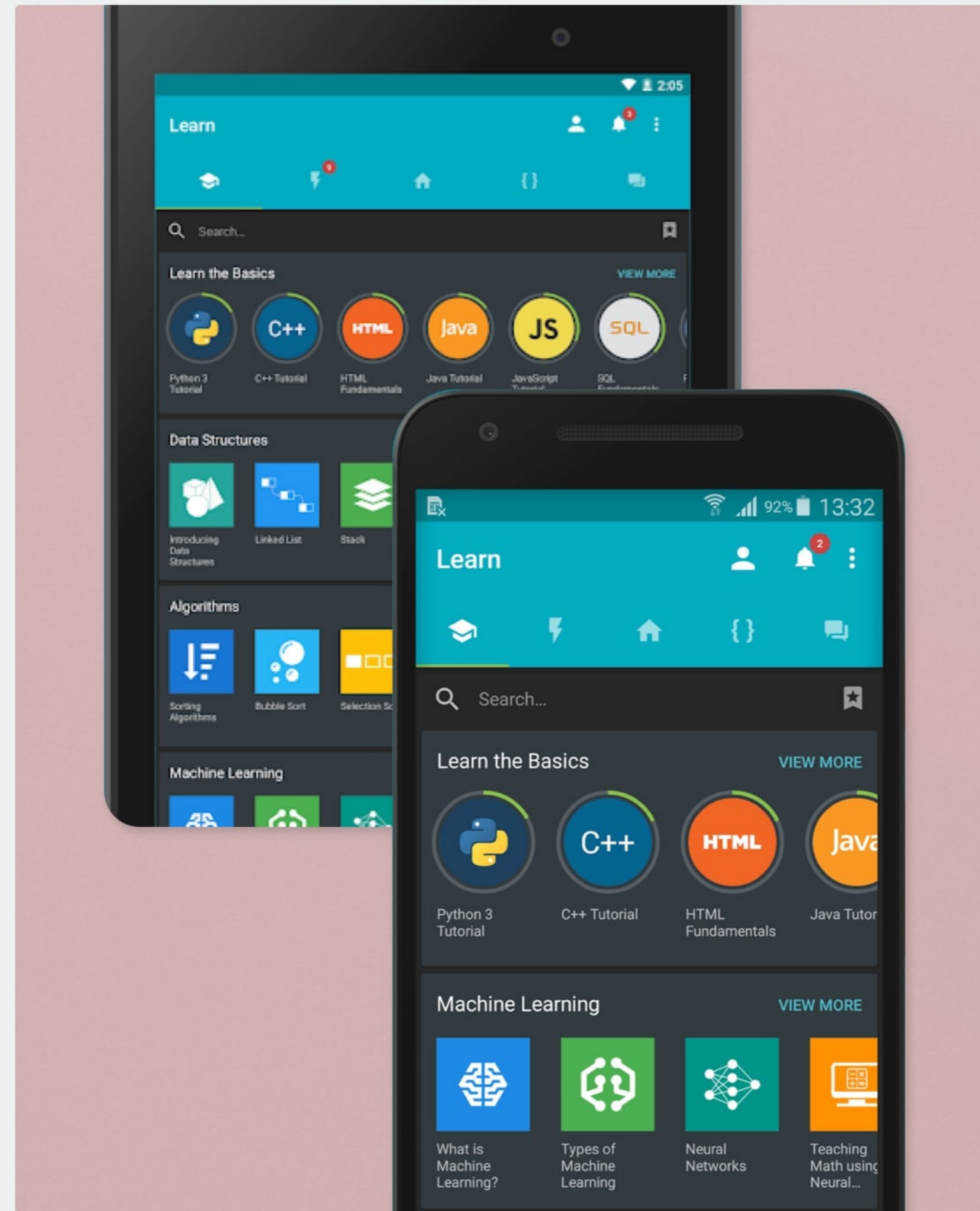

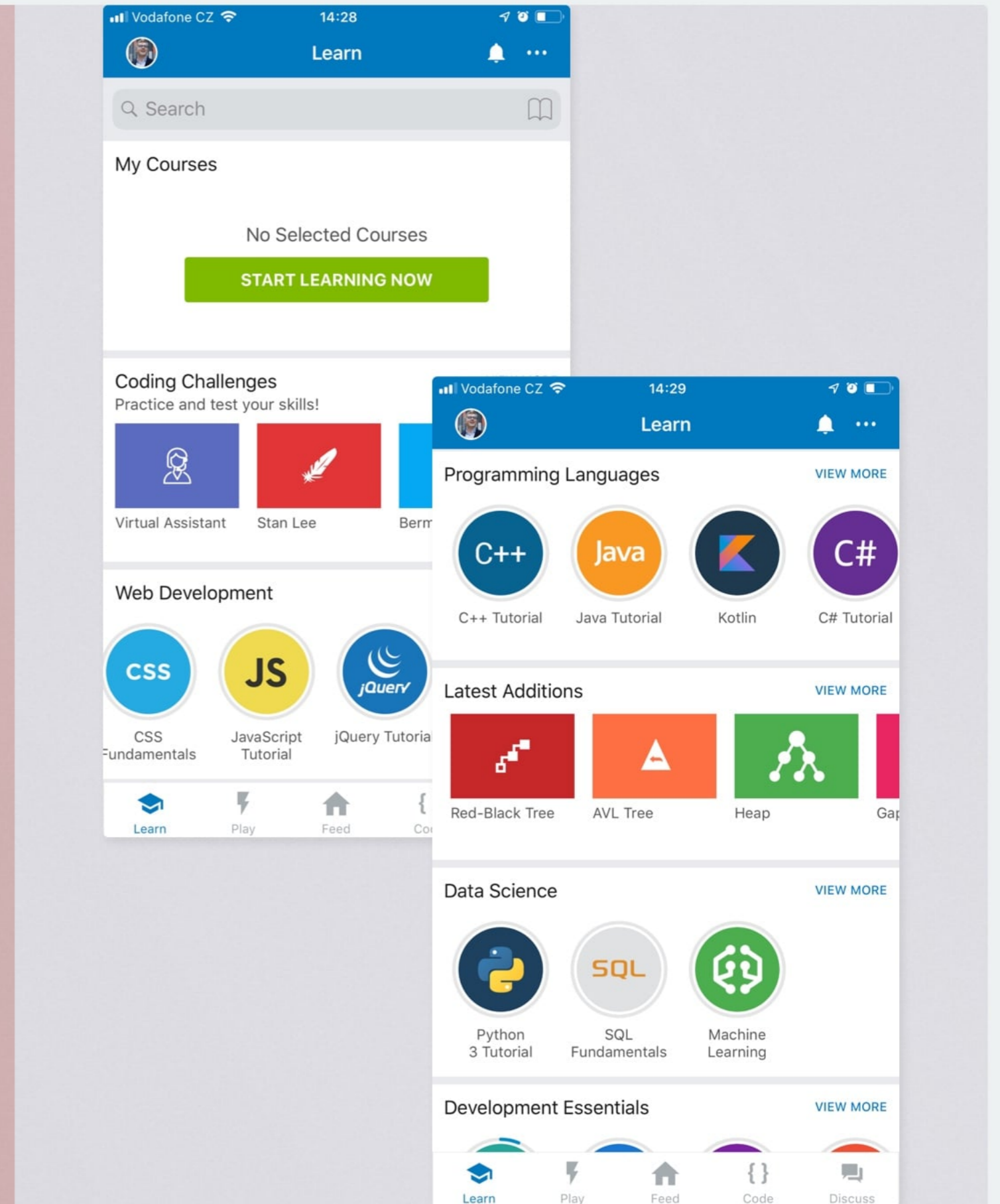
Main Task

Task limitations

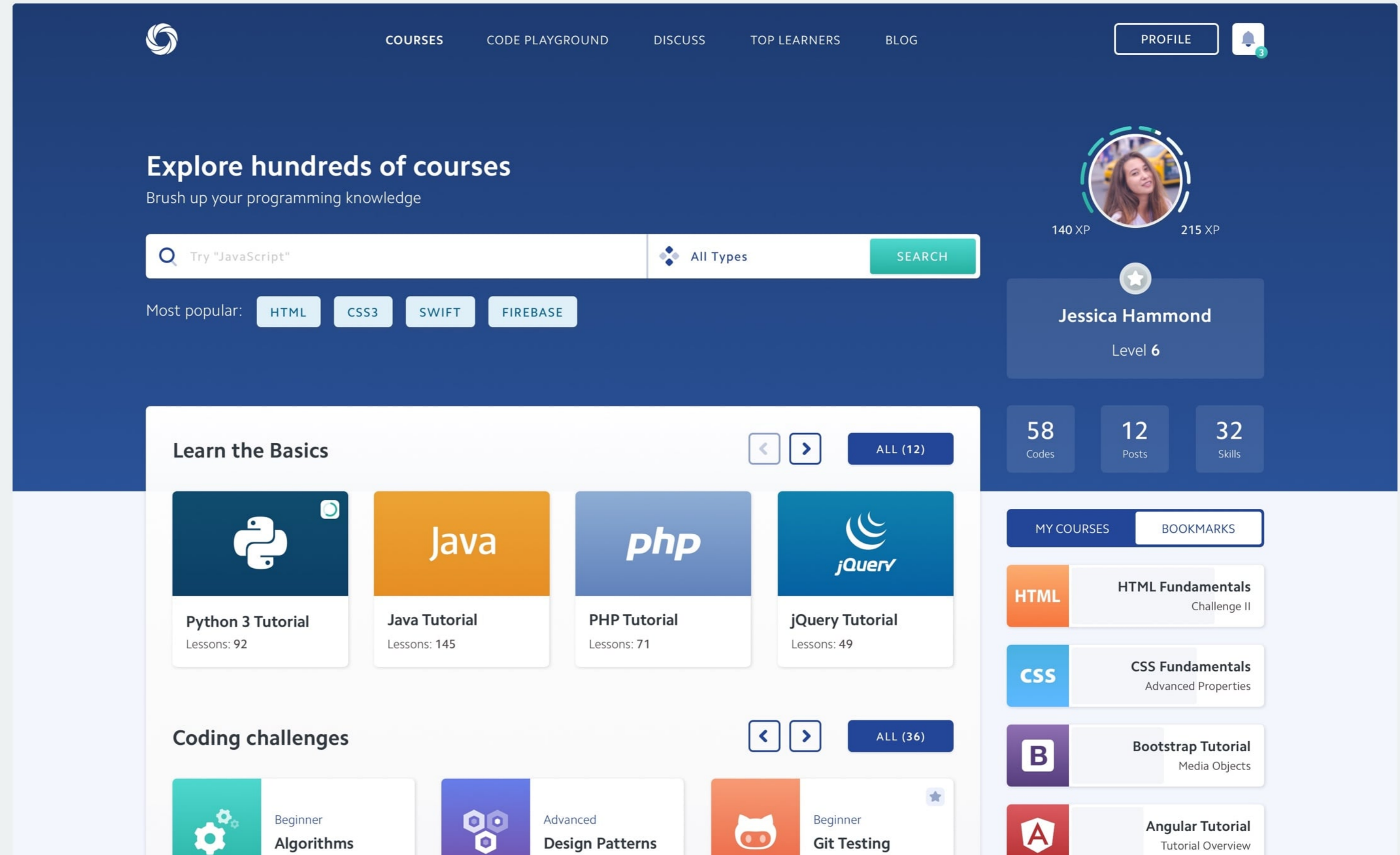
There were no strict limitations in terms of the exact colors, fonts, layout types etc.



Solution Idea

I wanted to use a benefit of a wider display to bring more useful elements for the users. For example, we have here sidebar panel with bookmarks and active courses or a more functional search panel.

For a content section, I decided to use a base layout similar to mobile versions (with side-scrolling). Since we have a lot of dynamic content here, it's better to keep cards in rows.

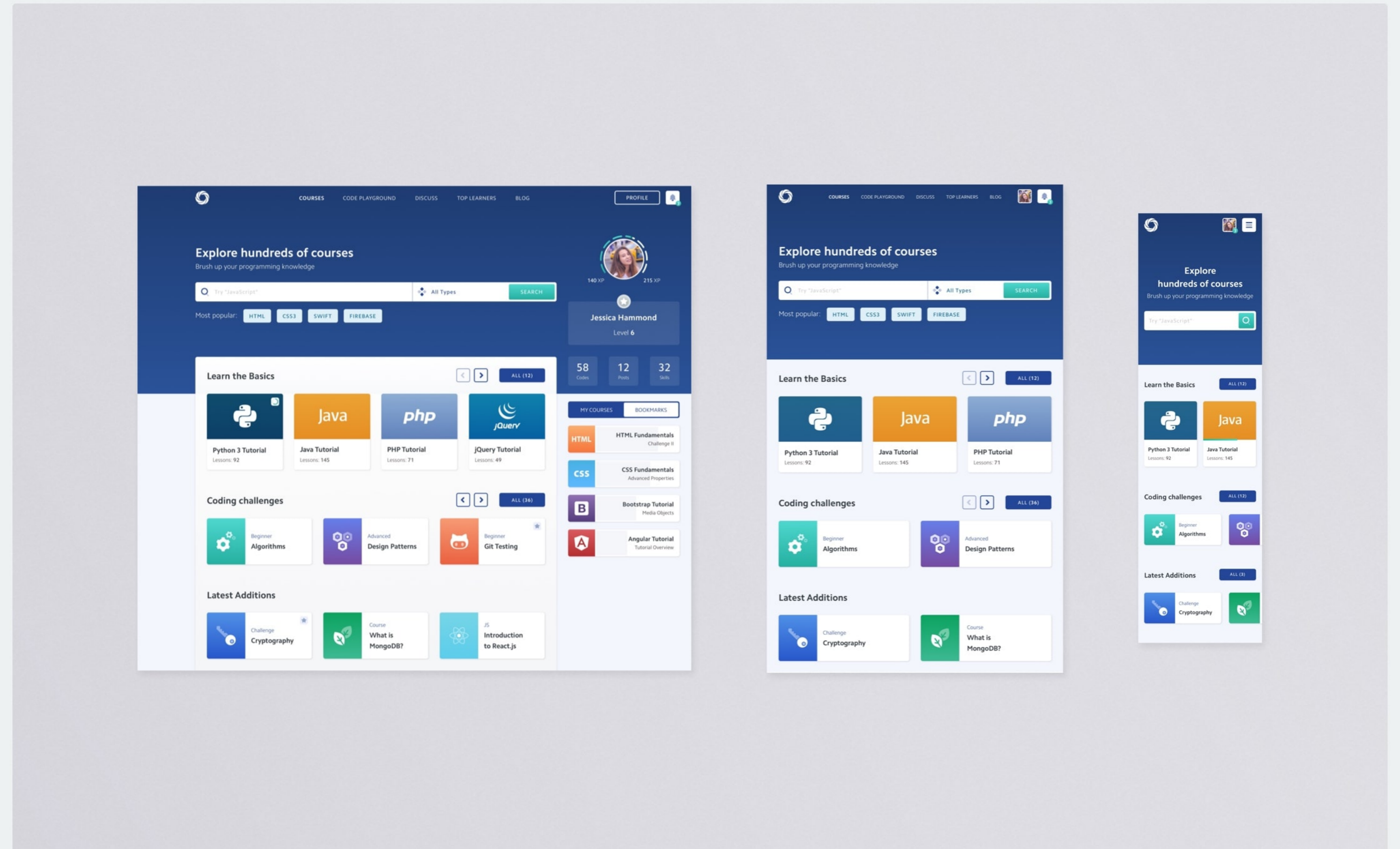

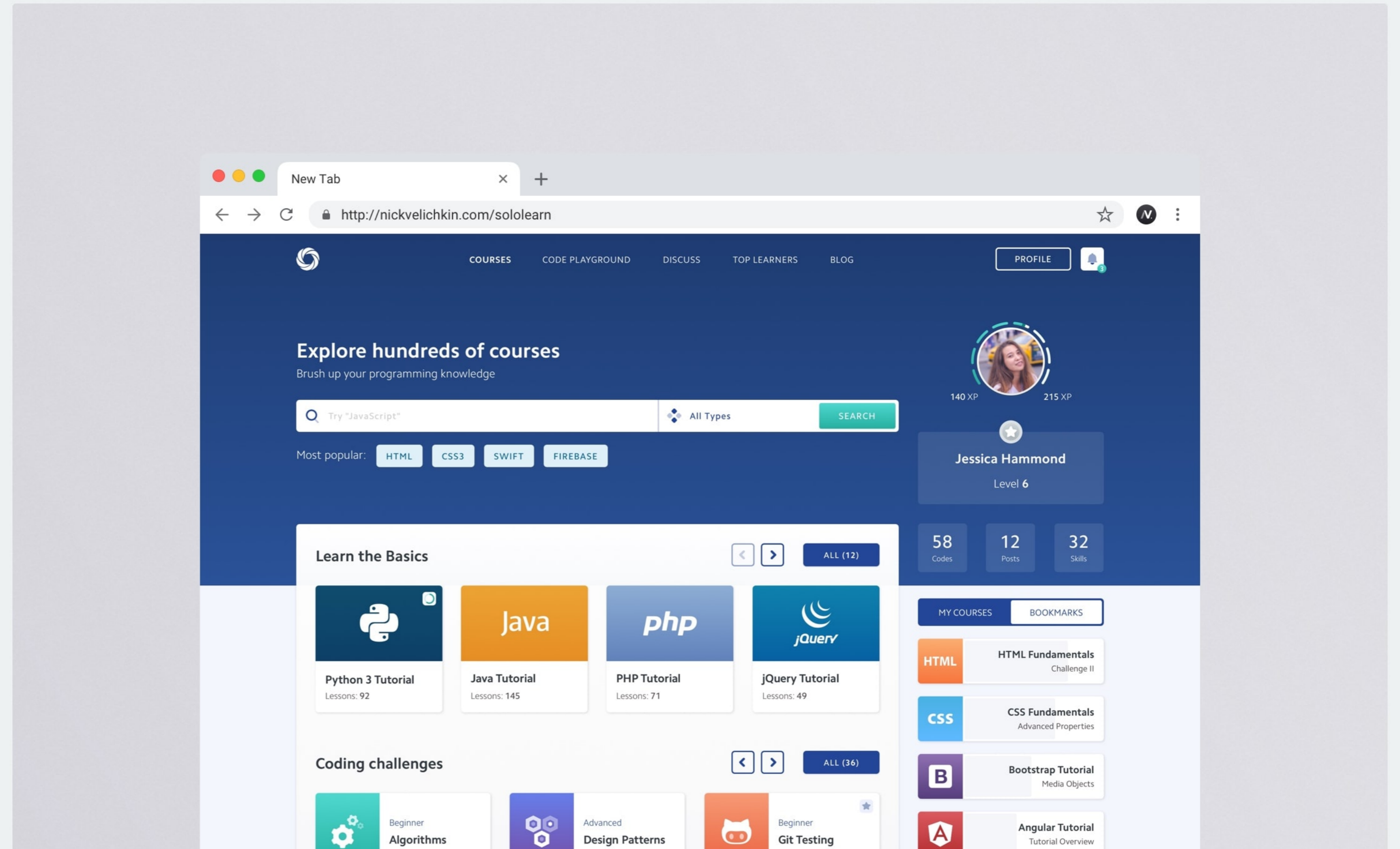
